AMENDED DECREE OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE, FINDINGS AND PERMANENT ORDERS

On November 11, 2008, December 5, 2008, and December 8, 2008, the above matter came before the Court for hearings. Mr. Brophy (Petitioner-Husband) appeared personally and was represented by Bradley C. Hibberd, Esq. Ms. Brophy (Respondent-Wife) also appeared personally and was represented by Dickie D. Lewis, Esq. At the conclusion of the December 8, 2008 hearing the Court took the matter under advisement. After considering the evidence presented and considering the credibility of the witnesses, the Court issued findings, conclusions and orders on January 8, 2009.

The parties subsequently filed requests for the Court to reconsider and to some extent correct the orders. Considering the requests, the Court hereby issues the following orders:

I. DECREE

1. The Court has jurisdiction over both parties based upon: both parties being residents of Colorado for more than 90 days prior to the filing of the Petition.
2. More than ninety days have passed since service of the petition on 11/13/2007.
3. The parties married on 03/23/1996 and separated on 10/20/2007.
